Read Notice Here Diploma in Nursery Teacher Training, or short form for NTT is a 1 year diploma course. The main focus of the program is to cater to the training of the nursery (pre-primary) level teacher workforce in India. The course aims at improving the overall quality of education at pre primary level and improving the quality of education. The NTT students are trained in areas like child education, teaching methodology, nursery level subjects & communication. The minimum eligibility criteria for the program is that the candidates are required to pass the 12th or equivalent examination in any stream with 50% marks. The admissions to this course are done mainly on the basis of merit list. However, few colleges prefer to conduct their own entrance examination. The average course fee ranges between INR 5000-INR 25000. The name of the course has however been modified to Diploma in Early Childhood Care and Education (DECE). The learning outcome of the course remains the same. NTT course is designed to train individuals in the skills and knowledge necessary to become nursery or preschool teachers.
