Boyds Bears is a line of manufactured collectable resin and stuffed teddy bears produced from the early 1980s until 2014. Boyds was acquired in 2008 by Enesco, who announced in 2014 that the company had "made the difficult strategic decision to place Boyds into hibernation". History Boyds Bears was founded in 1984 by Gary and Tina Lowenthal.[1] They were owners of an antique shop in Boyds, MD, which although profitable, found difficulty maintaining an inventory of well priced antiques. They turned to making and selling antique reproductions. Some of their more profitable reproductions included duck decoys. In 1984 they began sculpting with resin, at first making a line of miniature houses called "The Gnomes Homes". The first bear was a 12 inch tall stuffed bear with moveable joints named for the couple's newborn son, Matthew.[1] They began making and selling stuffed bears, and the bears became known as "Boyds Bears" after the town of Boyds, Maryland, where they lived and operated their business. The plush bears and hares were a success, and in 1993 Boyds introduced the first resin bears.[2] Enesco acquired the company in 2008 and retired the line in 2014.[1] The bears were a popular collector's item in the 1990s, and remain so now that they are no longer being produced.[1] Collectors club The Boyds Bears official fan club was called the "Loyal Order of Friends of Boyds!" It was founded in 1996. Newly designed kits were available annually. Benefits included exclusive members-only collectors items, an online newsletter and access to a members-only website. On August 14, 2014, Enesco announced that 2014 was to be the final year of the Friends of Boyds collector's club, and that retailer orders for the 2015 membership kit had been canceled. Awards Boyds products have won numerous awards in the toy and doll collectible circles. Some of these include Teddy Bear of the Year Awards, Doll of the Year Awards, Golden Teddy Awards, and National Association of Limited Edition Dealers Achievement Awards.[3] Closed Pigeon Forge Mega Store 5-26-07 Stores Boyds briefly operated stores including one in Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, near its corporate headquarters, and one in Pigeon Forge, Tennessee. The Gettysburg store closed early in 2011[4] and the Pigeon Forge location closed in 2007. In 1984, Gary Lowenthal designed a fully jointed, 100 percent merino wool teddy bear for his antique reproduction shop in Boyds, Maryland. That marked the beginning of the Boyds Bear plush bear line. In 1993, Boyds released its first series of resin figurines, which are as collectible as the plush line. In 2002, the 100th anniversary of the teddy bear, Lowenthal and his wife, Tina, opened Boyds Bear Country, a four-story flagship store on 130 acres in Gettysburg, Pennsylvania. The Boyds Bears line that was introduced in 1984 is retired. Retired Boyds Bears each have a name, including the very first plush bear that was designed by Lowenthal, which was named Matthew after Gary and Tina's son. Boyds Bears are available in many places online and off, making them readily available to collectors worldwide. The value of any collectible depends on its condition and rarity. A good place to find price guides for antiques and collectibles are used bookstores and public libraries. Boyds Bears are created with the highest quality standards, making them even more valuable. Lowenthal insisted that each bear was hand cut, hand sewn, hand embroidered and inspected by at least three people before it was packaged and shipped to stores. Not only do collectors of teddy bears and similar items experience the joy of owning something they cherish, they also can turn the hobby into a business. Many online and offline retailers of collectibles such as Boyds Bears were started by collectors. Many times, collectors amass collections so large that they have no option but to sell items, which eventually can turn into a thriving retail business. The question is why are people willing to pay such prices for a toy? The answer lies in a few commonalities. Top-selling teddy bears have the following attributes in common: low production, they commemorate a special occasion, and in one case, is the sole surviving example, according to Jacquie Denny, co-founder of EVERYTHING BUT THE HOUSE (EBTH). Plus, teddy bears have an emotional appeal to their owners, so they are willing to pay top dollar for early examples, Denny added, regardless of condition.
