With normal use, a timing chain should last the entire lifespan of the vehicle and doesn't need replacement. However, it's recommended to change the oil every 10,000 to 15,000 kilometers or once a year, as polluted oil can cause engine damage over time. Some helpful tips include: \* Check if the child safety lock is activated; it can often be deactivated with a mechanism in the door. \* Replace car keys batteries when they run out, as this can affect key functionality. \* Switch off the airbag on the passenger side when driving with a child in a car seat or for children up to 12 years old in the passenger seat. \* Always drive with the correct tire pressure; although lower pressure may increase road contact, it results in less stability. Remember that different brands and models have varying locations for the VIN number, but common places include the door jamb, under the hood, or on the metal flooring at the front seat. Replace wiper blades at least once a year if they show signs of wear such as streaking or leaving haze behind. Lastly, be aware that putting diesel in a gasoline car or vice versa can cause significant damage to the engine and other parts. Please note that any updates or clarifications made after the printed manual's editorial deadline are located in the appendix of the quick reference guide. Those parts and accessories listed by BMW are recommended for use. You can choose others, but make sure they're suitable for your vehicle. Changes need to be made at pages 7, 53, 90, 168, 226, 195, 196, 197, and 199 of the manual. At page 7, under homologation discussion, "may not" should replace "cannot". Also, remove "cannot" from page 7's Parts and Accessories section and change "cannot" to "does not". On page 53, in the safety belts section, have the work done by a service center for proper functioning. For special windshields on page 90, and at pages 168 and 226, use floor mats identified by the manufacturer as suitable. Page 195 mentions mounting, but disregard that and recommend having it done by a service center instead. The term "Approved" should be changed to "Recommended" on page 196 for wheels and tires. The text there should also mention potential risks with non-recommended wheels and tires. On page 197, discuss recommended snow chains only, as some types may not be safe. Finally, at page 199 under the "Hood" section, replace "may only use" with "BMW recommends using". 1. For page 202 "Approved oil types" change to suitable 2. Add sentence before gasoline engine chart: Use approved oil that meets standards 3. Ignore text before alternative oil types chart and replace with: If you can't use continuous use oil, add up to 1 US quart/liter of rated oil 4. Change "specification" to "rating" 5. For page 202 "Engine oil change" change to have work done at BMW dealer or another center with trained personnel 6. For page 204 second paragraph replace with: Manufacturer recommends using certified service centers 7. For page 207 and 210 replace text with: Xenon headlamp replacement can cause serious injury, don't perform work on them 8. Change "have any work" to "It is strongly suggested you" 9.
