Author: YOSHSHTrip dates: March 2001 Excellence Punta Cana can be summed up with the way some people see the beach. My wife & I (older travelers) see the sand on the beach as "sparkling gold." Some of the vacationers see him as a "dirty dark man" - these are the guys who are annoyed by everything. We arrived in Punta Cana on 10 February 2007. The airport was a mess. We had to wait on the asphalt and it seemed like there were a lot of planes unloading. (Basic sign). I don't expect much from immigrant people in the Caribbean, but being treated like cattle is not one of the things I like. It looked like a huge free for everyone. You were supposed to buy a tourist card, but there was no organization, no tidy line! He was every man for himself! I followed a guy who said goodbye to us to follow him, (it was a false hope). The problem was that there were ONLY 4 immigrants, and about 600 anxious tourists in a huge cluster. Now I resign from standing in line, without being obnoxious, and my wife is drooling in her ear, like it's all my fault. So far we are not having fun!! After an eternity, we finally got our bags and were quickly whisked to a regular sized bus with good air conditioning. The only thing I needed was a cold drink. We were told a lot that the trip to the resort was about an hour. I found the ride a little bumpy soothing. The road was flat and many pathetic people watching the They were grazers in weeds along the roads &   goats, cows, horses. The high mountains were out in the distance, the sun shining! Arriving at the excellence Resort, we were warmly welcomed with a beautiful smile, wet cold towels, and a one Drink. The desk was very personal and NOT CROWDED! The room we were assigned was not ready, so I asked to see a resort map for our room location (my wife wears 6 pairs of shoes, none suitable for walking long distances). I told the clerk I want to be close to things! We have declined the Excellence Club room upgrades - you will have a room with the pool outside your patio and some other dark amenities. Room 6010 was in the first cluster behind the Grill Restaurant, next to the pool bar, and that's all the upgrade I'll need. The wind pool extends the length of the west side of the resort (a quiet waterfall pool is located on the east side) and both pools seem to give everyone what they want: shady palm trees, full sun, full covered deck chairs (with full pillows) and steps from the beach. The beach itself is on the ocean side of the island. To you mud, that means surfing and UNDERTOW, so be careful. The beach is just as beautiful as any you'll find: swaying plams, those straw umbrellas, and plenty of activities and games for the exuberant. Every day they have a sort of picnic on the beach, food cooked in an enmorous pan, or classic beach grill of chicken, burgers and ribs. The aromas will take you away from the many distractions on the beach. Excellence is an adult only resort, so topless girls are scattered, a little more pleasing eye than others (try not to look). There is also horse riding (included), which is great fun. Horses know the way, so all you have to do is go back and forth. A nice walk along the beach, along the surf. I lost my hat, and it was recovered by one of the caballeros. I wasn't going to try to stop my horse and come back! I have more hats. They take your picture at the start of the race, (I made a Billy Crystal "Yahoo" by raising my baseball cap in my hand) and when you come back, your picture is on the label of a bottle of rum, and at \$15, a must-have. The rooms are big. You will find a large hot tub (on Valentine's Day, the maid filled the tub with bubble bath and flower petals). The King's bed seemed a little difficult for my particular princess. (I think they do it to increase thermal activity). The spacious room had a nice wicker table, a setee, desk, mini bar etc, and open to a patio which had REAL chickens (with baby chicks) foraging, very nice. The only drawback that was so close to a restaurant and pool bar, was the noise of the supply trolleys. They seem to roll them so early in AM. If that bothers you, ask for a more secular room. There is also a combination jogging track & eco park/garden at the front of the resort. A great place to walk out a great breakfast, complete with fish, parrots, pink flamingos, peacocks, ducks, chickens (with chicks). You'll like it. I also made the scuba, very beautiful coral, but SMALL boats, and some divers of maresick. Food and drink: Ask for your drinks to be made with the "best" brands, otherwise you will get local brands. they/they/theyGood brands, Absolut & Stoli, JD, CC, rum Barcardi, and a variety of favorite drinks after dinner, Baileys on the rocks is our special choice. They also have a show every night, big dancers, good singing, comedy, magic, you don't get bored. They have a private casino. There are so many restaurants we couldn't taste them all in six nights. We were located closer to the Grill. The fillet was swollen, but we found the tender bone, and baked on order. In addition, fresh, bubbly, tasty Mahi. Next to the Grill there was the Lobster House. My wife found the lobster a little soft, (he ordered steam, came to the grill, but it is in the Caribbean!) «Isabella» was the French restaurant and was considered the best. I ate duck liver disease, the taste was great, but I could feel my arteries obstructing. The lamb rack was great, my wife was disappointed with her salmon, a bit of fish taste. The only common theme at all restaurants is that there seems to be a huge delay after appetizers and salads. There are no reservations and the 30-minute Dominican wait is more than an hour, so get ready. "Barcelona" was like eating in an outdoor courtyard in Spain. (I never did, but I can imagine what it would be) stars shining on, with a threesome walking around a table, singing romantic songs. If you're a fish lover, take the whole "crusted salt" of fish. The fish arrived at the cropped table of salt as advertised, however it was headless (not a real problem for me) but I expected the head above. The server skillfully removed the crust and skin and threaded a huge amount of delicious white smoked fish on my tray, a show for itself. My wife ate a steak in a tasty sauce and was equally satisfied. We are sorry, but we lost the Italian restaurant and the Asian restaurant so I can't recense them (not enough time). Don't miss the Dominican Beach Party. What a great time, roast pig, grilled steaks, grilled lobsters, Dominican stew, etc. And dancing on the beach under the stars... If you're in love, this is for you! We found excellent service staff, always smiling, ready to help. I hope this will help. If you have any questions, send me an email!
