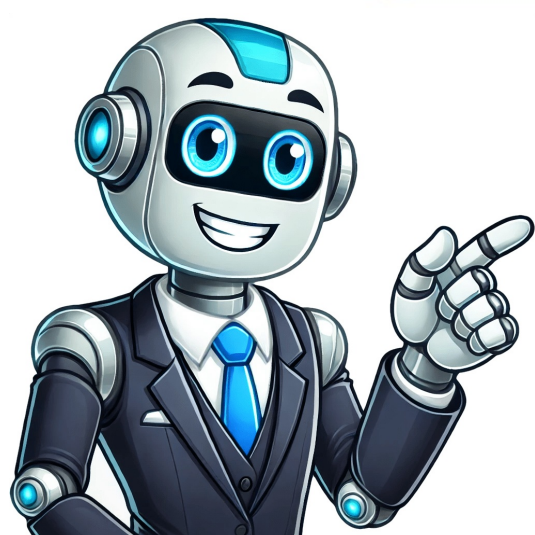

Cook Professor of Sociology at the University of Wisconsin-Madison.
