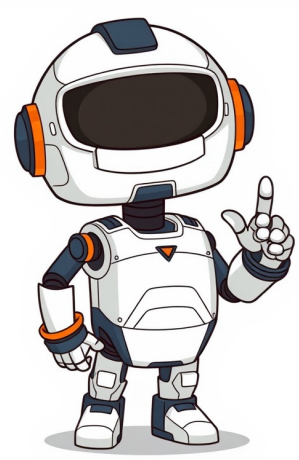


I'm not a robot



###ARTICLEAperire, meaning "to open" or "to blossom," has evolved from the ancient Roman goddess mythology. In May, the goddess Maia, who governed spring and life, was honored in the Roman pantheon. The month of May is named after her. June, however, is attributed to Juno, the wife of Jupiter, who ruled marriage, childbirth, and women, similar to the Greek goddess Hera. The Romans revered Juno and dedicated June to her worship. Consequently, the English month of June originated from her name. July, on the other hand, was named after Julius Caesar, who died in July after being assassinated. The Roman Senate chose to honor him by naming the month after his family's name, Julius. As a result, the English month of July evolved from the Latin word Julius. August, however, was named after the Roman emperor Augustus, who received the title "Augustus" (meaning "the most high") in 8 August. To avoid overshadowing Caesar, Augustus added an extra day to August, creating the larger months of July and August. The remaining days were then redistributed among the other months.
