## How to write a prayer petition

Prayers and petitions have always been an integral part of who and what I am. There were moments in the past where I thought I had a perfectly fulfilled life without it, justifying why my well-being lacked nothing, only to realize how empty I felt. This might not be something that is important to everyone, and I can respect that. But for me, my entire well-being is optimal when it is infused by the inner strength that Christ brings through the Word. I was raised in a typical Christian home, where we went to church every so often, read the Bible (maybe) on Sundays, and celebrated Christmas by starting off with the nativity scene from the Bible. My eyes were not yet opened to the Truth, tools, and precious gems that the Word provided prior to 2007, when I gave my heart to Jesus. It was through attending a non-denominational life group, that I was empowered with the right tools and were able to utilize, apply, and reflect on how prayers and petitions empowered, influenced and changed my life. Through this guide, I hope to provide others with the tools to write prayers and spiritual petitions that will bring about change in their lives, because the Word works if you work the Word. I have numerous testimonies of how these prayers of petitions (later referred to as petitioning prayers) influenced different aspects of my life, as well as others'. The way I see it, is that you literally have nothing to lose, and everything to gain. I am overwhelmed with how God blessed me personally through spiritual blessings, physical blessings, financial blessings, familial blessings and through protecting me from certain situations. My motto has always been Romans 8:28. Romans 8:28 reads (Amplified version): "And we know [with great confidence] that God [who is deeply concerned about us] causes all things to work together [as a plan] for good for those who love God. to those who are called according to His plan and purpose." What is the prayer of petition? Petitions that are written in the form of prayers are power-tools to speak that which you pray for, into existence. Yes, God only has plans to prosper us. I believe that with all my heart. I'm not saying that bad things won't happen to good people. I'm saying that God works everything together for the greater good, He gives us life in abundance through Jesus, and the devil is the culprit who steals, kills, and destroys (John 10:10). It is our God-given responsibility to continue in prayer, writing petitioning prayers, and pray without ceasing. These petitioning prayers contain Biblical sustenance to fuel your prayer, desire, or petition into coming to fulfillment in God's time. In addition, these petitioning prayers also use the Bible to site specific promises, outcomes, and affirmations. Of course, there is a scripture that is applicable to every situation in your life, but you need to delve deeper into God's Word to learn what His blueprint is for your life. Unfortunately, there's so much strife, dispute and controversy that arises in religious institutions or affiliations nowadays, that people cleave onto dogma instead of onto Jesus. I do not associate myself with religion, but rather with belief. What I believe in, is God and His Word, Jesus Christ, and Holy Spirit. I believe that there are many ways to pray and as the saying goes- "to each their own", however, there is a more beneficial way to pray in order to get the desired results, and manifested promises that is bestowed upon us through Jesus Christ, in God's Word. Is there a wrong way to pray? Certainly not. But through using this "prayer of petition" format, I can testify this became a power tool in my prayer life, so that I was able to check so many things off of my "prayer wish-list". How to get started with writing the prayer of petition Reason The reason I write petitioning prayers, is because the Word says we should. One Timothy 2:1 (AMP) says: "I urge that petitions (specific requests), prayers, intercessions (prayers for others) and thanksgivings be offered on behalf of all people." Furthermore, Habakkuk 2:2-3 confirms this- "Write the vision; And engrave it plainly on [clay] tablets, So that the one who reads it will run. For the vision is yet for the appointed [future] time It hurries toward the goal [of fulfillment]; it will not fail. Even though it delays, wait [patiently] for it, Because it will certainly come; it will not delay." It is a little bit different than your standard prayer you pray quickly heading out the door on your way to work. It is a premeditated, written prayer which is meant to fulfill a purpose; a vision; a dream; a request. Motivation You need to figure out the "what" of your reason behind your prayer. Take time, be still before God, and start writing down (or typing) what exactly it is that you would like to see manifest in your life: whether it pertains to spiritual, financial, physical, or emotional desires. I love to write my petitions with the help of Holy Spirit. Just really connecting with and tapping into the Helper that God gave us. My first few petitions were all handwritten, until I realize how much time it saves me to just type it! Be Specific Be specific! If you desire to see an increase in your finances, write specific goals that should fall into place in order for you to achieve the desired outcome. The desired outcome I write usually includes the name of the person (if the prayer is for someone else than yourself), the desired solution to the situation (e.g. health, healing, clarification, assurance, comforting, protection, prosperity, a new job), and intertwine these specifics with scripture. Typically, I specify my desired outcome to the last detail, e.g. if the petitioning prayer is for a new job, then I include the position, the maximum distance from my house, the desired salary, possible benefits, that I have favor manifested, and if it's a job that I REALLY want, I call upon my Godly favor and claim the job as mine, as if it already happened. You might ask, why do I believe this with such boldness? Because my God is "able to [carry out His purpose and] do super-abundantly more than all that we dare ask or think [infinitely beyond our greatest prayers, hopes, or dreams], according to His power that is at work within us" (Ephesians 3:20, Amplified version). Scripture For every goal, desire or petition, there is a corresponding scripture. Make sure to jot down two or more scriptures next to each goal, desire or petition. Why two or more? Two Corinthians 13:1 tells us that "Every fact shall be sustained and confirmed by the testimony of two or three witnesses." I prefer to type my petitions, because I have simultaneous access to searching for specific scriptures that relate to my topic. Faith Be authoritative over what you pray for. Pray as if you ALREADY received it. Mark 11:24 clearly states that WHATEVER you ask for in prayer, BELIEVE that you HAVE received it. Past tense, right? Right. That means you need to PRAY and BELIEVE. I can honestly say, in the beginning of my spiritual walk, I had a hard time with this. Not because I didn't believe, but because I didn't know HOW to hold on to that belief. Until it struck me when I read, understood and made Romans 10 mine. Romans 10:8 reads "...the Word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart". and then Romans 10:17 reads that faith comes by hearing, and hearing the Word of God. Well, that sums it up! You need to pray this out loud, so you can build faith when you hear it, and through praying it out loud, you speak it into existence. Speak life The petitioning prayers are filled with (or should I say consist mainly of) God's Word. Hebrews 4:12 (NIV) says that the "word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart." And then to top it off, Proverbs 18:21 says that the "...tongue has the power of life and death, and those who love it will eat its fruit.". Wait a minute- this says the tongue, not the mind, correct? The tongue means you need to speak it, not think it. 10 Steps to writing your own prayer of petition Start with the reason why petitions are written (1 Timothy 2:1)Motivate why your petition to God needs to be fulfilled (Habakkuk 2:2-3)Integrate scriptures that remind God of His promises (Isaiah 43:26). God didn't forget. He wants you to know and stand on His promises for you. These promises can include God's plans to prosper us (Jeremiah 29:11), God supplying all your needs according to His riches and glory (Philippians 4:19), that we are justified and reconciled to God through Christ (Romans 3:24), our heavenly heritage through Christ (Ephesians 1:11), life in abundance (John 10:10), no weapon formed against you shall prosper (Isaiah 54:17), complete healing (Isaiah 53:5), everything that has a name is subject to the Name of Jesus Christ (1 Corinthians 15:27), God's divine protection from disease, pestilence, or any harm (Psalm 91:11)Thank God for granting your petition through Jesus Christ (1 John 2:1; Hebrews 9:15)Thank God for bringing this petition and your needs therein to fulfillment in the appointed time (Psalm 103:20; Matthew 6:8)State and specify (call it by name) your needs/dreams/desires pertaining to the following to name a few: spiritual (e.g. growth, fulfillment, love walk with Christ, gifts of the Spirit, discernment, deliverance, guidance, protection, marriage), physical (healing, health, pregnancy, diagnosis, hormonal), financial (new job, increased finances, debt, bonus), and emotional (anger management, fear, confidence, depression, ambition).Praise God for His Word that is actively fulfilling His promises to you, and is unwavering (Hebrews 4:12; Psalm 119:89).Like any petition, confirm it with the testimony of 2 or more witnesses and ask someone that you trust, to stand in agreement with you (2 Corinthians 13:1). Date it and sign it.Continue to thank God daily for granting your petition. Tips for success in writing a prayer of petition Write one petition for one matter (e.g. new job, pregnancy, clarity on a decision), otherwise we can keep on writing forever and a day.Find 2 or more supporting scriptures for your petition's every request.It is not a formula. It should be from YOUR heart.Write it down (or type it).Speak it, believe it, receive it.Put it up somewhere where you see it daily.Pray for it, then praise God for it.Don't complicate it, and write from your heart. I'm just very detail-oriented!If you are still unsure or unable to identify areas of your life that need petitioning prayers, I started out with Stormie Omartian's books to help guide me. She is a phenomenal Christian writer, and her books are something I would definitely recommend! There is something for everyone: mother, father, husband, wife, daughter, son, you name it. FAQ about writing a prayer of petition How do I find time to write my prayer of petition? I find it very helpful to spend time to write my first template for my prayer of petition, with Steps 1 through 5, and Steps 7 through 10. Thereafter, I am able to adjust the prayers specific to Step 6. I might add more scripture pertaining to my petition, or remove some scriptures that doesn't pertain to my petition or request. For example, I will not add scriptures about healing when I am petitioning God for a new job, otherwise this prayer of petition will be too long. How do I find time to pray my prayer of petition? Prayer is a God-given responsibility. The Word works if you work the Word. If you have a hard time finding time to pray your prayer of petition, then find small gaps throughout the day where you can break your petition into sections. However, I find it easier when you devote 5 minutes in your routine to pray it, then it's done and dusted. It's like a daily vitamin- if I don't take it after I brush my teeth, I might as well not take it at all. I like to pray when I get ready in the morning, while I do my make-up. If I'm running a bit late, I keep a copy in the car. Rise up against distractions, sit down, and just do it. No one will do it for you. It's your responsibility alone. You have the power tools, so use it. A nail is nothing without the use of a hammer. Nail it! When do I pray my prayer of petition? As soon as you're done writing it, of course! If you write your petition in a requesting manner (e.g. Lord I ask You to..., because You promise in Your Word...), then you may use it as a daily guidance in your time of prayer. I prefer to write my prayer of petition in a thankful manner (e.g. Lord, I thank you for..., because Your Word says...), as if I already received it. When I write my prayer of petition in a thankful manner, I can continue to thank God for it. When we pray, we only ask once, and thank God after that. If you continue to ask and ask and ask for the same thing, that means you didn't believe that you received it when you prayed for it (Mark 11:24). How often do I pray my prayer of petition? Affirmations are important. Once you prayed it, make sure you thank God daily for it. Thank God through praying the prayer again if it's written in a thankful manner. Remember to always pray out loud- the Word tells us WHY this is important (in Hebrews 4:12 and Proverbs 18:21). I like to put it on the side of the fridge, and every time I walk by, I say "Thank you Lord for granting this petition, in Jesus' Name". Speaking it into existence and praying those scriptures out loud, also helps to build your faith. Who can sign my petition? People that you trust, that are believing with you for your petition or request. Don't let someone sign who will mock or ridicule you for what you believe in, because they are not in agreement with what you are petitioning. My petition is personal, where do I put it? I like to put mine next to the fridge, where only my husband sees it. If you live in a household with numerous members, try finding a spot that is your safe haven, like the inside of your closet, in your makeup drawer, on your desk, under your pillow, in your Bible, in your diary, in your daily planner; anywhere where you will remember to daily thank God for granting it. I need help writing my prayer of petition, do you have a template? Yes, of course! Using an existing template is the simplest way to get started. It makes it easier to see how and what to include, and in which format it would be easier for the reader to follow. You can find yours FREE here: The last thing you need to know about writing a prayer of petition ANYONE can write and pray the prayer of petition. It should not be regarded as a formula for writing the prayer of petition, but rather using the guidelines to write your own heartfelt prayer of petition. The purpose of the prayer of petition, is to give you the boldness to act upon God's Word and promises. This provides a faith boost to walk in alignment with His blueprint for your life. It is not complex, as the blueprint for each and every prayer is already in God's Word, ready to be unlocked. It takes motivation, faith, and a little bit of time to write the prayer of petition that will have a tremendous impact on your life and prayer life. Through the prayer of petition, I was blessed in so many ways when requests, desires and prayers became fulfilled. It is never too late to start, and you have absolutely nothing to lose.
